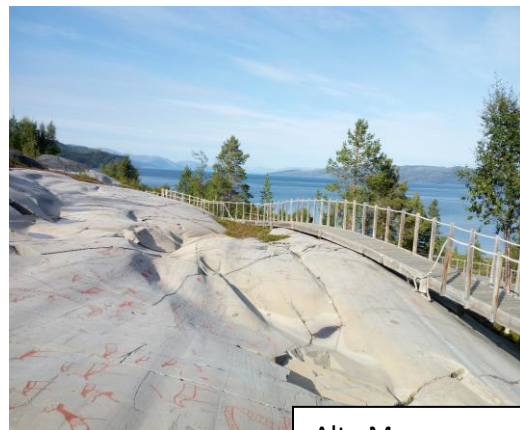
Please note: You **MUST** apply for student housing to have a room reserved for you. Students who have not applied for housing must look for housing in the private market.
